Materials List

Learn how to paint a portrait under the direction of local artist Maria DeSimone Prascak of Maria's Ideas; MariasIdeas.com. Provide your own supplies or purchase a material's kit, which includes the canvas, brushes, and paints you will need for your session. Visit aviary.org to reserve your spot today!

For each session, you will need:

- 11" x 14" canvas board*
- 1/2" Filbert brush*
- 1/2" Flat brush*
- 1" Flat brush* OR a 1" sponge brush
- Round line detail brush*
- Pencil
- Water basin to clean brushes
- Paper towels
- Paint pallet. A paper plate or egg carton work well.
- Template (provided via email prior to each session)
- Smock (optional)

The paint colors you need will differ for each session.
