Uncompromising Care

The world was turned upside down by the COVID-19 pandemic. We adapted to rapid changes and adjusted to uncertainties that eventually became "the new normal." Amidst all of this upheaval, however, little changed for the animals that call the National Aviary home, and our work to save birds, protect their habitats, and deliver outstanding care continued.

For many years, the National Aviary has worked on the ground in the Mariana Islands, home to a number of birds threatened by the same invasive snake species that decimated bird populations on Guam decades ago. On the heels of the good news in late 2019 that the Guam Rail had been downgraded from being Extinct in the Wild to Critically Endangered, a string of hatchings in 2020 shine as a beacon of hope and a testament to our commitment to caring.

First, we celebrated the hatching of two Guam Kingfishers. Like the Guam Rails now thriving on islands near Guam, these kingfishers are the descendants of only a handful of birds rescued from the brink of extinction by conservationists in the 1980s. The hatching of these two birds offers hope that a return to the wild awaits the Guam Kingfisher.

And, while our work on the ground was paused in 2020, in December, for the first time at the National Aviary, we saw the fledging of an Endangered Mariana Fruit-Dove. One of only 44 Mariana Fruit-Doves in human care, this chick's hatching represents progress for this species.

Every bird matters, and this is especially true for Endangered species like the Bridled White-eye of the Mariana Islands. Aviculturists noticed that Tasi, a lively bird weighing only eight grams, had nesting material entwined around his leg—something that is not uncommon for such a small species, both in the wild and in human care. Fortunately, Tasi lives at the National Aviary and was able to receive immediate help from a caring veterinary team. Tasi's injury had happened quickly and required surgery. Our veterinary team performed the delicate procedure on Tasi, whose legs are about the size of toothpicks, and created a custom cast for him, changing it each week for six weeks. The process was painstaking and exacting for the veterinary team, but well worth it. Tasi didn't let the cast slow him down! He was a model patient, and with physical therapy, he made a full recovery.

The National Aviary's commitment to caring and the support of a generous community of donors helped bring extinct-in-the-wild chicks into the world, nursed beloved birds back to health, and made milestones like an endangered species' first fledging possible.



Giving Education a Place to Grow

Education is at the heart of what we do at the National Aviary, and an essential avenue for the delivery of our mission.

In recent years, our education programs have grown quickly, serving upwards of 25,000 students annually. In March 2020, we were faced with a new challenge – delivering our mission without in-person learning, as schools closed and field trips were canceled in response to the pandemic.

Our team worked diligently and quickly to launch a new virtual education platform: CyBIRD. CyBIRD offers distance-learning opportunities for classrooms, adapting some of the National Aviary's most popular programs to create an immersive, engaging virtual experience for students. Additionally, a lineup of online programs for families provides a fun extracurricular experience for school-aged students.

Creating new virtual education opportunities allows us to be creative in developing programs and increases our capacity to reach new audiences and meet bird lovers around the world. These new virtual offerings will continue into the future, while we consider and plan for in-person programming that helps kids and families connect with nature and birds at the National Aviary, with safety at top of mind.

Giving Education a Place to Grow cont.

In October of 2020, we completed construction on The Garden Room,

a 9,000-square foot event and education space overlooking Lake Elizabeth in Allegheny Commons Park. A project years in the making, The Garden Room is purposefully designed, versatile, and equipped with industry-leading sustainability features, including windows and doors incorporating bird-safe glass from Vitro Architectural Glass, which open up to a beautiful terrace and garden.

The Garden Room's design offers a connection to nature with state-of-the-art amenities, making it the perfect setting for events from weddings to showers. Importantly, The Garden Room's open and functional design lends itself to hosting in-person education programming during a time of physical distancing and into the future.

With interior connectivity to the National Aviary's habitats via The Charity Randall Foundation Eagle Hall, The Garden Room is poised to host education programs that are engaging and immersive. The completion of this project also offers a solution to the shortage of space, providing a meeting place when we can learn together, in person, once more.

The Garden Room's project team was led by Perfido Weiskopf Wagstaff + Goettel and Jendoco Construction Corporation. Atria's Specialty Catering and Vitro Architectural Glass are sponsors of The Garden Room.
